

AA GB ECSC EMAIL ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

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PURPOSE

AA GB has invested in the necessary resources to ensure that it is able to make the most of the advantages offered by modern electronic communication methods. This Email Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) document applies to all members of the fellowship using aamaail.org hosted email accounts.

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

Use of the email service by members of the fellowship in service roles is encouraged where such use is suitable for Public Information purposes and usage that supports communication of AA Service information in keeping with the spirit of 12 Traditions of Alcoholics Anonymous.

STANDARDS OF USAGE

Email accounts should not be used for the following :-

- Communications unrelated to Alcoholics Anonymous.
- Solicit emails that are unrelated to Service activities or for personal financial gain.
- Send or receive any material that is obscene, racist or defamatory or which is intended to annoy, harass or intimidate another person.
- Represent personal opinions as those of AA GB GSO.
- Upload, download, or otherwise transmit illegal material.
- Upload, download, or otherwise transmit commercial software or any copyrighted materials belonging to parties outside of AA GB GSO.
- Perform any other inappropriate uses identified by the Electronics Communication Sub-committee.

The use of computing resources is subject to UK law and any illegal use will be dealt with appropriately.

Use of email may be subject to monitoring for security and / or network management reasons. Users may also be subject to limitations on their use of such resources.
