

Accessing your aamail.org inbox

You can access your new email via webmail at <https://webmail.aamail.org>

Username: - *****@aamail.org

Password: - *****

The new webmail facility now provides secure encrypted access to your email secured by a signed certified certificate.

If you wish to keep any emails from your old mailbox, please forward them to your new address. They will not be automatically migrated.

The storage limit of all new accounts has increased, however we ask that old emails are not stored for longer than needed.

If you wish to use an email application instead of the webmail function eg. MS Outlook, gmail, mobile phones and email apps.

The following server information will allow you to set up your client application.

Server Type: IMAP

Incoming IMAP Server: mail.aamail.org

Outgoing SMTP Server: mail.aamail.org

Username: Your email address

Password: Your password

Please make sure outgoing as well as incoming servers are configured.

For enhanced security, this server also supports SSL encryption for both incoming and outgoing transmission of data from your email application. It is recommended that you enable SSL encryption if your client application supports it.

IMAP SSL port 993

SMTP SSL port 465

Please make sure outgoing as well as incoming servers are configured.

Please note the certificate for this subdomain while not signed by a third-party vendor to reduce costs to the fellowship is still valid to provide encryption to/from the server.
